Invocation

P: In the name of the Father,

P: And of the Holy Spirit,

C: Who has given us a second birth.

Sing: Thrice holy! Father, Spirit, Son,
Mysterious Godhead, Three in One,
Before Thy throne we sinners bend;
Grace, parson, life, to us extend (#242, v.4 - TLH)

Confession of Sins

P: When I kept silent, my bones wasted away

C: Through my groaning all day long.

P: For day and night your hand was heavy upon me;

C: My strength was sapped as in the heat of summer.

P: Then I acknowledged my sin to you

C: And did not cover up my iniquities.

P: I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord,"

C: And you forgave the guilt of my sin. (Psalm 32:3-5)

Sing: "With Broken Heart and Contrite Sigh" (#303, vs. 1-4 - CW)

P: God, our heavenly Father, has been merciful to us and has given his only Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins. Therefore as a called servant of the Word and by the command of the Lord Jesus Christ I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

P: Blessed is he

C: Whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered. (Psalm 32:1)

Sing: "With Broken Heart and Contrite Sigh" (#303, vs. 5 - CW)
